

We have submitted our area designation request to the Vale, which is the first step in the Neighbourhood Plan process. The next step is to set up a Steering Group which we will do at the next meeting on 27th September.

VACANCIES FOR PARISH COUNCILLORS

We now have two vacancies for parish councillors and recruitment is becoming urgent. Can you help? The Parish Council is the first tier of local government, whose official purpose is to improve the quality of life and wellbeing in the community and deliver services to meet local needs. In East Challow the PC reviews all planning applications. maintains playgrounds and public spaces and ensures that other bodies (such as the county and district councils) carry out their obligations to maintain public areas. The PC also initiates and carries out projects for the improvement of the village, makes grants to local organisations and runs the village website. Councillors must live in the parish, and need to have done so for a year to qualify. The PC meets once a month on a Wednesday evening. Councillors also attend meetings and carry out site visits when considering planning applications. Tasks are shared – you don't have to do everything – but we need a full complement of Councillors to ensure everything gets done. Supporting and maintaining our excellent village and its community is interesting and satisfying. Please consider whether this is a role you would like to take on.
