



# **Vicar's Letter**

### **Dear Friends**

We went for our regular dental check up recently. Both the dentist and hygienist asked us very detailed personal questions about our teeth cleaning habits.

- How often and for how long do you brush our teeth?
- What sort of toothbrush do you use?
- Do you use interdental brushes?
- Are you pregnant?

And then, of course, followed the intimate and personal investigation in our mouths which we allow because we believe good teeth and oral hygiene are important.

It did make me wonder whether people would undergo a **spiritual** checkup? Answering such questions as:-

- How often do you pray?
- When do you read the Bible?
- Do you give time to reflect and meditate, especially about God's love?
- Do you meet with others to praise God?
- Are you generous?

## Community Policing cont.

- 6. Double check the facts. Make sure you fully understand the total costs of the transaction -including estimates, delivery and installation and the arrangements for aftersales servicing.
- 7. Talk to someone you trust for a second opinion.
- 8. Don't hand over a cash deposit. Avoid handing over money before work is started. A reliable trader will never ask you to do this.
- 9. Think very carefully before you agree to a trader starting any work straight away. If you agree to have any work done or goods delivered within the seven day cooling-off period, you may have to pay if you later change your mind and cancel the contract.
- 10. Trust your instincts. If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is.

## Community Policing - PCSO Howard Pack C9600 - Thames Valley Police

Over the past few months there have been a number of incidents where residents have been offered Goods or Services at their front doors and being abused when they politely say 'No thank you', these persons are commonly known as 'Nottingham Knockers'.

Traditionally Nottingham Knockers go door to door selling dusters, cloths, tea towels etc, but could be anything. Traditionally they come from Nottingham, but could be anywhere.

They were flash ID at the homeowner, and ignore cold caller stickers. Many residents find them intimidating and are pressurised into buying items from them.

Door to door sellers, or their correct term Pedlars, require a permit which they get from the Chief Constable FROM THE AREA THEY LIVE IN. The permit lasts for a year. Often they present a home made permit that has been printed off from the net, and, as most people do not know what a real permit looks like they think they are genuine.

Regardless of whether they show you a permit, real or not, I would like you to call the police. You do not need to tell them you are calling the police. Just say 'no thanks' or don't answer the door, and call us on 101. We will then come out and do the rest. We take all of their details, check them out and will deal with any offences. This is how you can help us, and we will do the rest.

# Could residents also be aware of other Doorstep Traders with the following advice;

- 1. Never sign on the spot.
- 2. Check the trader's identity. Always ask for an identity card and look up the organisation to check the salesperson's identity is genuine.
- 3. Be wary of special offers or warnings about your home.
- 4. Always shop around for the best price.
- 5. Read the small print. Always read documents carefully before you sign them and make sure you fully understand your rights.


