



A 21-year East Challow woman who works with adult social care teams at Oxfordshire County Council has been given a special award linked to her apprenticeship.

Gemma Tuckey, who works in the Contracts Team, in Joint Commissioning based at County Hall has been awarded the Special Recognition Award at the Oxfordshire Apprentice Awards 2017.

She was one of hundreds of apprentices from across Oxfordshire to be nominated for the award. She joined Oxfordshire County Council in September 2014.

Gemma, a resident of East Challow near Wantage, and a former pupil of King Alfred's Sports Academy in the town, said: "Prior to my apprenticeship I studied health and social care at college, where I got low grades, and was struggling to see a light at the end of the tunnel. I decided to choose an apprenticeship and I began as an intermediate apprentice studying Business Administration for a year in the Engagement Team at Oxfordshire County Council.

"I decided that I wanted to carry out the Advanced Business Administration apprenticeship so I stayed on in my team and carried this out for another year.

"I worked hard in my role and dealing with large projects and issues in my day to day work helped me gain the experience to work in my job today, as a Quality and Contracts Officer in Learning Disabilities.

"I never thought I would win this award but I did. I am so proud of my journey and am grateful for all opportunities that The Council has handed me in the last 3 years."

Kate Terroni, Director for Adult Social Care at Oxfordshire County Council, said: "We are very proud of Gemma and we know that she would like to thank everyone who has supported her to achieve this award.

"Gemma is a bundle of energy and her success shows how we at Oxfordshire County Council put time and effort in to helping members of staff grow and mature. Gemma is very much 'one of our own'. I have had a number of dealings with her over the last few years have been very impressed."

#### Notes to editors

Since 2006 Oxfordshire County Council has recruited more than 300 apprentices across all of its services. Apprenticeships provide an opportunity for the council to develop its workforce and provide employment and training opportunities for individuals in the wider community. All apprentices are paid a salary and given the opportunity to complete nationally recognised qualifications.

## **Church Alterations: Toilet, Entrance and Servery**

We now have permission from the Diocese to proceed with the project. The aim is to make the church more welcoming, accessible and more usable for a wider range of church and village activities; by sensitively introducing some modern facilities, making the building more compatible with the needs and expectations of the 21<sup>st</sup> century. This involves providing a toilet suitable for disabled people, reorganising the entrance area, adding some basic catering facilities, and making the external access more disabled friendly with the path ramped up to the entrance.

We have detailed plans and costings; and a budget figure  $\sim £50,000$ 

Although we will do some parts of the work ourselves and we hope to raise some of the total from grants, there is still an urgent need for substantial direct giving, and fund raising.

We will formally launch the project over the weekend of 13/14<sup>th</sup> May, with a Gift Day on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> May.



## Village News

#### **OUR VILLAGE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN**

Presentation of the Neighbourhood Plan (NP) for East Challow took a step forward at a packed public meeting in Challow & Childrey Cricket Club on Monday 13th March where more than seventy villagers took part in an exercise to examine the strengths, weaknesses of the village, and the threats and opportunities facing it in the future.

The Government created neighbourhood planning to empower local people to direct and shape the way their communities grow and develop into the future. If the Plan meets basic conditions, set out in law and checked by an independent examiner, the community can vote on it at referendum; if more than 50% of the people who vote say 'yes', the District Council formally adopts the plan and uses it in deciding planning matters.

East Challow Parish Council wants to develop a NP in order to:-

- provide for changing housing needs, have a say in where housing is sited, in what type of housing is developed, and in the style of development
- preserve the rural character of the village and focus new development in areas which do not disturb the heart of the village.
- avoid congruence with Wantage
- encourage development in the area which contributes to the development of the Western Relief Road and thus reduces the current traffic flow on the A417
- see increased employment opportunities in the vicinity
- encourage more housing and facilities for the elderly and for young families
- address transport issues
- preserve the high quality and accessible countryside setting of the village and protect the valued neighbouring green spaces.
