



Community Policing - PCSO Howard Pack C9600 - Thames Valley Police

Over the past 7 months I have been given more responsibility and an increased workload to cover incidents in WANTAGE, this is due to Staff sickness and shortages, this has meant I have not been able to patrol GREENDOWN as often as I would like.

I have recently completed a 'Problem Solving Profile' on WANTAGE Town Centre Parking and my report

Has been submitted for review; during this time I issued 61 Parking tickets in a 3 month period.

Thames valley Police are introducing a new Policing Model starting on 01/06/2017, this will involve the redeployment of resources and will enable us to be more flexible when tackling Police incidents.

I will be remaining as the GREENDOWN PCSO (EAST & WEST CHALLOW, CHILDREY, LETCOMBE REGIS BASSETT) with additional responsibilities for Rural Crime, Ridgeway & Beauty Spots, Parking, Speeding and Speed Watch.

Fraud and identity theft

Understanding how to keep your personal details and identity safe is one of the best ways to prevent yourself from falling victim to fraud or identity theft.

Be cautious of anyone asking for your personal or financial details. Your bank, the police and other reputable companies will never ask for this type of information over email or the phone.

To protect yourself:

- never give personal details to anyone who contacts you unexpectedly
- don't carry documents or bank cards unless you need them
- · always shred unwanted documents such as bills, bank statements and even mail
- keep personal documents in a secure place
- report lost or stolen bank cards and personal documents immediately
- · check bank statements as soon as they arrive and always report any unusual activity
- · always keep your card in sight when paying at a shop or restaurant
- · don't respond to unsolicited phone calls or emails




