





Dear friends,

We helped move our son, Luke, into his new home. His brother and sister provided the muscles, his mother the excellent sustaining lunch and the skill I provided is the ability to pack a van tightly and securely. It was so much quicker this move because we did not have to climb 4 flights of stairs so we had time to help assemble some of the furniture.

I managed to put some of the screw bolts of the bed in incorrectly but fortunately Luke knew what he was doing and we had it in place and comfortable very quickly. However, the solid oak dining table which Luke and his wife had been given took us 5 attempts and a lot of discussion to get it right before it was fully functional. There was no one to guide us and no instructions either!

ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

This year's Annual Parish Meeting is being held on Tuesday 22 May, starting at 8pm in the Village Hall. All villagers are warmly invited to attend. As well as a report from the Parish Council about local issues and the year's events, the evening includes updates from village organisations on their activities. Tea and coffee will be served.

POTHOLES

Snow, ice and salt have damaged our roads beyond expectation and capacity to repair right now.

Reports to Fix My Street averaged about 2000 per month and County Council highways teams were set up to respond to this need. But Fix My Street reports are now about 7000 to 8000 per month and the teams can't get round fast enough. Potholes have been raised to the top of Oxfordshire County Council's agenda, and the Government has provided £2.8 million more for pothole repairs so extra repair teams will be going out from April with an additional dragon patcher which is most effective on rural roads. Please keep reporting the potholes you see, but do not expect immediate repair, or response from officers.
