Notes of Meeting with VOWH Wednesday 4th January 2017

- 1. A Neighbourhood Plan cannot stop development
- 2. Presumption of sustainable development exists only in the built-up area designated in the Local Plan
- 3. Try to establish WHY we want to prepare the NP (ie. to help influence development locations, to help build village community spirit, sense of village togetherness)
- 4. Project Plan should start with SWOT analysis of (a) the village, and (b) the steering group and its members, and include a suggested vision for the village, a consultation statement and a basic condition statement (ie. conformity with Local Plan, national guidelines, sustainability and environmental requirements, EU etc)
- 5. We should withhold our view of developers' proposals until the NP is accepted
- Funding available:- £10k from VOWH on acceptance of our project plan; £9k from "Locality" (see mycommunity.org.uk on acceptance of project plan. The Parish Clerk will be the Responsible Finance Officer for the NP.
- 7. We are urged to contact others who are already advanced in their NP development (Wantage, Faringdon, Longworth, Blewbury, Cumnor, Appleton) to discuss development of questionnaires, publicity, suitability of consultants.
- 8. VOWH Community Engagement Officer is "Louise"
