

# Dear Friends

This month I offer a short thought about good routines and bad habits. In the army we were taught not to set patterns of behaviour because they can become vulnerable to attack from the enemy.

On the other hand, I read this about the two Antarctica expeditions and the importance of consistent routines whatever the weather. Amundsen's team walked 20 miles only, each day whatever they faced, Scott's team often did more but rested on bad weather days and the one we largely remember resulted in the sad death of all Scott's team on the return journey. Consistent spiritual routines pay off wherever we are and whatever we face, especially in times of change.

What we need is that old adage of having the wisdom to know the difference. As s a Christian I find it wonderful to be able to pray to the Lord to receive guidance to know which can become a dangerous bad habit and what is a constantly beneficial routine.
