



Twentieth Anniversary

of 'Open the Book'



The Open the Book scheme is a

scheme enabling members of the local church to visit the local primary school to tell the children and staff stories from the Bible.

For over seven years members from St Nicholas Church have been welcomed into St Nicholas C of E Primary School every Thursday morning. This usually involves members of the team and child volunteers dressing up and using various props to tell a bible story either from the Old or New Testament of the Bible.

This scheme started in Gloucestershire twenty years ago and has spread rapidly, now involving over 3000 primary schools over the UK with over 17000 volunteers taking part.

Two of our volunteers went to Gloucester Cathedral on Tuesday 14th May to join in a celebration service with about 600-700 other storytellers. It was an amazing and very uplifting service lead by the Bishop of

Gloucester, The Rt. Rev. Rachael Treweek.

Many of the children at St Nicholas School made posters, depicting a Bible story they had enjoyed or a prayer they had written which we proudly took to Gloucester Cathedral to be placed in a book to celebrate the twenty successful years.


