



Dear Friends

Easter is early this year - but then the spring flower seem to know this already. Our daffodils were sprouting just after Christmas. So, by the time you receive this March letter we will be in the middle of Lent.

The churches in the Benefice are using the course "Acts of Love" for our Lent Groups which Canon Fr Robert Teare prepared for the Oxford Diocesan Partnership in World Mission. In the course we will be looking at different ways we can express our Christian love.

It is of course never too early to perform any act of love. Indeed the greatest act of love there has ever been is celebrated at Easter when we recall one innocent person giving up his life to save a world which opposes God. It is a crime to allow a dog to foul any public area without cleaning it up. By doing so you could face a fixed penalty notice of £50 or prosecution.
